In the heart of our community, both Howard and Hervey Bay Uniting Churches serve as beacons of hope for those seeking to overcome the challenges of alcoholism. Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) offers a compassionate and supportive fellowship where individuals come together to share their experiences, strengths, and hopes.

In Howard, AA meetings are held every Wednesday morning at 9:30 am. These gatherings provide a safe space for individuals to connect and support each other on their path to recovery.

Hervey Bay hosts two distinct AA groups. On Tuesday mornings at 11:15 am, there is a dedicated group for women, providing a nurturing environment for women to share and heal. On Thursday mornings at 9:30 am, a mixed group comes together, offering a diverse and inclusive setting for all attendees.

These meetings are more than just gatherings; they are a lifeline for many, fostering a sense of community and shared purpose in the journey towards sobriety. Through mutual support and understanding, participants find strength in numbers, ensuring that no one has to face their struggles alone.
