Your Church Needs You

If you do internet banking, have some computer skills and would like to make an important contribution to the operations of our church, this calling may be for you.

With most of our financial tasks now carried out by Synod BookKeeping Services, the duties of the Volunteer Church Treasurer have been significantly reduced.

A typical week is, mostly, processing bill payments through ANZ internet banking, then emailing the bills to BookKeeping Services for them to record in the Xero finance system.

With the Office Secretary generating most of the invoices such as for hall rental, you might need to recharge some costs to other churches in our congregations, to Blue Care or to Hervey Bay Sixtys' and Better. But this is easy.

Tasks relating to quarterly monthly reporting, quarterly business activity statements (BAS), budgeting and Annual Financial Returns are now managed by BookKeeping Services with minimal involvement by the Church Treasurer, if, at all.

Our new Volunteer Church Treasurer will commence duties from February 2025 but it is anticipated that the handover and familiarisation with procedures and practices will start at an appropriate date before then.
