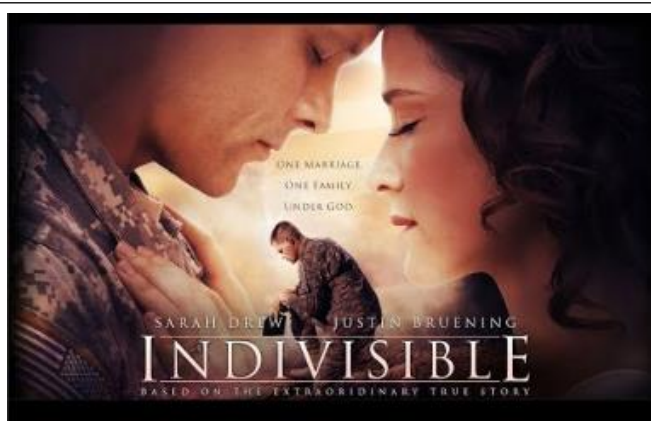

Our Prayer Tree for Christmas

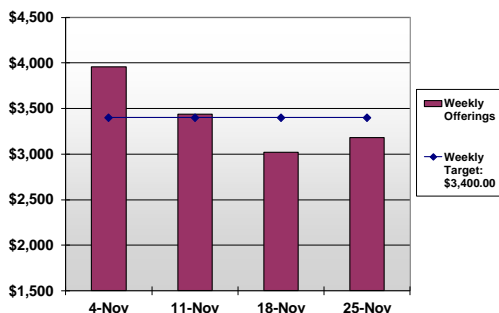
