What people with dementia most need from us—is us. Memory Bridge exists to end the emotional isolation of people with dementia. We bridge people with and without dementia to each other in life-changing ways.

The "I Am a Bridge" training program teaches the three skills of presence that transform ordinary listening into transformational attention—the kind of relating to others that opens us both to new depths of possibility and meaningfulness.

These skills are not "tools in a toolbox", nor techniques for managing behaviours. Skills of presence are movements of heart, mind, and consciousness. They are a way of being with others in which we risk vulnerability by letting go of our certainties, expectations, and the need to be in control.

And we learn these skills from each other, in relationship. Many participants describe the experience as life-changing.
