As we move towards the start of the 2025 school year, we have an urgent need for volunteer RI instructors

Currently approximately 1400 children in our local area have parent consent to attend weekly RI classes in our area, but only 900 are receiving RI lessons due to a shortage of volunteer instructors.

RI is currently offered in some form, in only 5 of the 8 primary schools in our area due to a shortage of volunteer instructors

30 minute RI lessons are usually presented weekly. Curriculum/Training and resources are provided. Prospective RI instructors must be endorsed by their Church leader; hold a current Blue Card and complete the required training.


